

Privacy and Cookies Policy on the notice-gdpr.info website

AURACO Sp. z o.o. places particular importance on respecting the privacy of users visiting websites in the *.notice-gdpr.info domain. Data collected in log files are used solely for website administration purposes. Apart from the data voluntarily provided in the contact point form, we do not seek to identify users of the AURACO pages. Data from the form is passed solely to the data controller on whose behalf we operate the given contact point, and solely for the purpose of handling the request submitted. We do not pass any data to anyone else.

Data Collection

Consistent with the practices of most web services, we store HTTP requests sent to our server. The viewed resources are identified by URL addresses. The exact list of information stored in the server's log files includes:

- The public IP address of the computer from which the request came (it may be the user's computer directly).
- Client station name – identification executed through the HTTP protocol, if possible.
- Time of request arrival.
- The first line of the HTTP request.
- HTTP response code.
- The number of bytes sent by the server.
- URL of the previously visited page by the user (referrer link) - in the case when transitioning to the AURACO website occurred through a link.
- User browser information.
- Information about errors that occurred during the execution of the HTTP transaction.

This data is not associated with specific individuals browsing AURACO pages. To ensure the highest quality of the service, we occasionally analyze log files to determine which pages are visited most often, which web browsers are used, whether the site structure contains errors, etc.

Contact point – exercising data subject rights

In subdomains where the data controller has instructed us to operate a contact point, the service provides a form for submitting a request concerning the rights of a data subject (Articles 15–22 GDPR).

The controller of the data provided in the form is the entity named in the legal information on the contact point page. AURACO sp. z o.o. processes it as a processor, under a data processing agreement concluded with that controller (Article 28 GDPR), solely in order to receive the request and forward it.

We collect: the subject of the request and its description, the first name and surname, the e-mail address and – if provided – a telephone number. Where the request is made on behalf of another person, additionally that person's first name and surname and an indication of the basis for acting on their behalf. We do not ask for a scanned power of attorney or for a national identification number.

Together with the request we record the public IP address from which it was sent and the time it was submitted. This data serves solely to protect the form against abuse and to evidence the circumstances in which the request was received.

The form contains a hidden control field, invisible to the person filling it in, and measures the time taken to complete it. We also limit the number of requests accepted within one hour from a single e-mail address and for a single controller. These measures serve to distinguish submissions made by people from automated ones and do not result in automated decision-making within the meaning of Article 22 GDPR.

We send a confirmation of receipt to the e-mail address provided, together with a single-use confirmation link valid for 7 days.

The retention period for a request is determined by the controller on whose behalf we operate the contact point; AURACO keeps the data for as long as the data processing agreement requires, and deletes it or returns it to the controller once that agreement ends.

Rights under the GDPR are handled by the controller named in the legal information – requests concerning data provided in the form should be addressed to that controller. For matters concerning the operation of the service itself, write to kontakt@auraco.pl.

Use of Data

The collected logs are stored indefinitely as supplementary material used to administer the website. The information contained therein is not disclosed to anyone except those authorized to administer the server and the AURACO network. Based on the log files, statistics may be generated to assist in administration. Aggregate summaries in the form of such statistics do not contain any identifying features of visitors to the site.

Information on the so-called "cookies" mechanism

The service uses only one technical cookie – JSESSIONID – necessary to maintain the browser session. It is a session cookie: removed when the browser is closed, accessible only to the server (HttpOnly flag) and not sent to other sites (SameSite=Lax). It does not serve to identify the user and is not used for analytical or marketing purposes. Under Article 173(3)(2) of the Polish Telecommunications Law, storing this file does not require the user's consent, as it is necessary to provide the service. The service uses no other cookies, in particular none originating from third parties.

The AURACO website may contain links to other websites. We cannot be held responsible for the privacy practices of these sites. We encourage you to read the privacy policies of these sites when you visit them. This privacy policy applies only to AURACO's websites.
